



## Thursday, August 13<sup>th</sup> @ LEGION MEMORIAL GC

### Game Rules

- Rule #1 – Have FUN!
- USGA rules govern all play
- This is a scramble format: All players tee off. Select the ball which the team will play from. All players will hit their 2nd shot from within one club length of that location (6" on green) & no closer to the hole. The ball must be played from the same cut of grass (i.e. if ball chosen is in rough then partners' balls must be played from the rough as well). Follow this procedure until the ball is holed.
- White tees for the men and green tees for the women. Each player must use at least 2 drives per 18 holes (par 3's count).
- PACE OF PLAY: All groups must keep up with the group in front. If your group is out of position, you may be subject to a 2-stroke penalty. Pace of play should be 2 hours and 15 minutes for each side or less.
- **We will be doing LIVE SCORING throughout the round.** Please make sure at least one person per foursome downloads the FREE Golf Genius app prior to teeing off. Once you download the app you will need to enter your GGID# that is on the bottom right of your scorecard. Once you enter that GGID# you will need to click on your name and then start entering scores for your foursome.
- **2 PUTT RULE IS IN EFFECT (if on the green). Each player will make an attempt at the first putt and if nobody makes the putt you will pick up and count the next stroke as holing out. If you were putting for 3 on first putt and all miss, you will take a four and move on to the next tee.**
- Stroke Limit: **Max score of double bogey.** For example, if on a par 3 you don't score a 4 or lower, pick up and take a 5 and move on. If you are more than 1 hole behind the group in front of you, please feel free to skip a hole and take a par.
- Competition Holes:
  - #5 KP – Women (\$50 to Legion's Pro Shop)
  - #9 Longest Drive – Men (\$50 to Legion's Pro Shop)
  - #13 KP – Men (\$50 to Legion's Pro Shop)
  - #18 Longest Drive – Women (\$50 to Legion's Pro Shop)
- Remember rule #1!
- 1st place team will be awarded the tournament champion plaques. Ties will be decided by a scorecard playoff. A playoff is decided by adding the last 3 holes (18, 17, & 16). If there is still a tie then the last 6 holes (18 – 13), and so on. Results will be announced during lunch, after the round of golf concludes.
